These include, but are not limited to:

- Door Handles
- Push Plates/Light Switches
- Desks/Phones
- Tables
- Counter Areas
- Restroom Fixtures/Lavatories
- Breakroom/Conference Room
- Elevator Buttons
- Handrails
- Cafeterias/Kitchen Areas
- Drinking Fountain
- All highly touched areas
- Washing hands consistently (20sec).
